


ACTIVITY TIME

1. WARLI ART OR MANDALA

Warli painting is a style of tribal **art** mostly created by the tribal people from the North Sahyadri Range in India. This type of painting is one of the most intriguing forms of Indian folk painting.

Only geometrical shapes (lines, triangles, circles) are used for creating the magnificent scenery or to explain numerous concepts.



A **mandala**, which is Sanskrit for “circle” or “discoid object,” is a geometric design. The **mandala's purpose** is to help transform ordinary minds into enlightened ones.

Prepare a Mandala or a Warli Art using different shapes (use of colours in optional).
